PARTICULARS

- Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 129, s. 2017, the division will conduct the 2017 White Cane Safety Day to support the efforts of the Department of Education in promoting good governance through respect and realization of all human rights. - B) Color My World Contest (for Learners with Cerebral Palsy) -Coloring Contest


