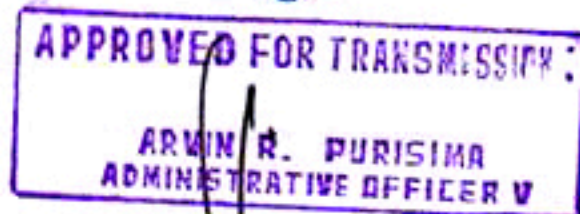
Participants to this activity are first place winners in the Municipal Level English Olympics and their coaches.

**2017 DIVISION ENGLISH OLYMPICS**  
Guidelines and Criteria  
Nov. 17, 2017, Bautista NHS

Theme: "Shaping the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Learners with English Skills for Global Competitiveness"

**1. SPELLING**

- a. Open to all bonafide Grade 7 students who won first place in the municipal English Olympics
- b. Reference is Ventures in English 1
- c. Coaches should prepare the following:
  - 1 easy word (for one point) - 2 syllable-word
  - 1 average word (for 2 points) - 3 or more syllable-word
  - 1 difficult word (for 3 points) - words with silent letters, no foreign word, No proper noun
  - 1 clincher
- d. Words should be encoded on a ¼ long bond paper (portrait), size 12, Times New Roman, in small letters
  - Word to be spelled including the diacritical mark
  - Word should be used in the sentence
  - Reference, page number
- e. Contestants should use ¼ illustration board to write their answers, chalk and eraser

**2. ESSAY-WRITING**

- a. Open to Grade 8 students who won first place in the municipal English Olympics
- b. One hour is given to the contestant to develop his/her composition
- c. Criteria:
  - Content/Relevance to the topic - 40%
  - Mechanics - 30%
  - Organization of Ideas - 30%
  - 100%

**3. QUIZ BEE**

- a. This is an individual contest for Grade 9 students who won first place in the municipal English Olympics
- b. Reference- A Journey Through Anglo-American Literature
- c. Coaches should prepare the following:
  - 1 easy question with 4 choices (for one point)
  - 1 difficult question with no choice (for 3 points)
  - 1 clincher
- d. Questions should be encoded on a ¼ long bond paper (portrait), size 12, Times New Roman, in small letters
  - question
  - choices (for easy round)
  - answer
  - Reference, page number
- e. Contestants should use ¼ illustration board to write their answers, chalk and eraser

**4. POEM WRITING**

- a. This is for Grade 10 students who won first place in the municipal English Olympics.
- b. A student is given an hour to prepare and write his/her piece.
- c. The poem style is free verse or with s rhyme scheme.
- d. Criteria:
  - Relevance to the topic 40%
  - Use of poetic devices 20%
  - Creativity/Originality 40%
  - 100%

**5. EXTEMPORANEOUS SPEAKING**

- a. Open to all bonafide Senior High school students (Grade 11/12) who won first place in the municipal English Olympics
- b. Contestant should not wear school uniform or any identification; only casual attire
- c. A contestant is given 3 minutes to prepare his/her piece and 3 minutes to deliver his/her piece.
- d. A green flaglet is shown up to start the delivery, yellow flaglet as warning and red flaglet to stop.
- e. Criteria:
  - Content/relevance to the topic - 30%
  - Delivery - 30%
  - Organization of ideas/reasoning/analysis - 30%
  - Demonstration of sense of confidence and style - 10%
  - 100%
