

## **PARTICULARS**

Reading is a core skill. The 21st Century Skills will remain a dream unless all basic education learners are able to read with comprehension. One of the key standards at the end of the first stage, i.e. Kinder to Grade 3 is: every child a reader in the mother tongue at end of Grade 3.

However, reports have been received by the Central Office that there are still nonreaders even in Grades 7 and 8 and readers with very poor comprehension in higher grades.


In view of this, schools are required to submit the following:

- a. ALL ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS: Pre and Post Results of Philippine Informal Reading Inventory (Phil-IRI) for SY 2017-2018.
- ALL SECONDARY SCHOOLS: List of Non-Readers and readers with very poor comprehension skills per Grade Level in JHS and SHS.

Duly signed printed copy of the required data shall be submitted to the Office of the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent (Dr. Pagatpatan) on or before June 7, 2018.

The data will be useful in crafting programs, projects and activities for the Division Education Development Plan (DEDP), which shall improve the reading skills of our learners.
